By Public Transport - Hufelandweg 14 (barrier-free)

- Coming from the main train station or Nordbahnhof, take the streetcar lines M5, M8 or M10 and get off at the stop Invalidenpark. Alternatively, take bus line 147 in the direction of "U Leopoldplatz" from the Friedrichstraße train station, also to the Invalidenpark stop.
- Turn right at the square in front of the Neues Tor into Hannoversche Straße, where the north entrance of the Charité-Campus is located. Your destination is the white building, which can be seen from the barrier on the left.
- The entrance is located on the south side of the building. There is a limited number of paid parking spaces available in front of the building.

By Public Transport - Bonhoefferweg 3 (barrier-free)

- From the train station "Friedrichstraße" take bus line 147 in the direction of "U Leopoldplatz" to the bus stop Charité - Campus Mitte.
- Coming from the main station, also take bus 147 in the direction of "S Ostbahnhof" to the bus stop Charité - Campus Mitte.
- Enter the Charité-Campus via the entrance Luisenstraße 9 and turn right into Hufelandweg before turning left into Bonhoefferweg. Number 3 is located on the right side.
- There is a limited number of paid parking spaces available on the campus.

By Public Transport - Virchowweg 6 (barrier-free)

- From the train station "Friedrichstraße" take bus line 147 in the direction of "U Leopoldplatz" to the bus stop Schumannstraße.
- If you are coming from the main station, also take the bus line 147 in the direction of "S Ostbahnhof" to the Schumannstraße stop.
- Then turn west onto Schumannstraße and follow it to Charitéplatz.
- Follow Virchowweg straight ahead. Number 6 is on the left.
- There is a limited number of paid parking spaces available on the campus.
